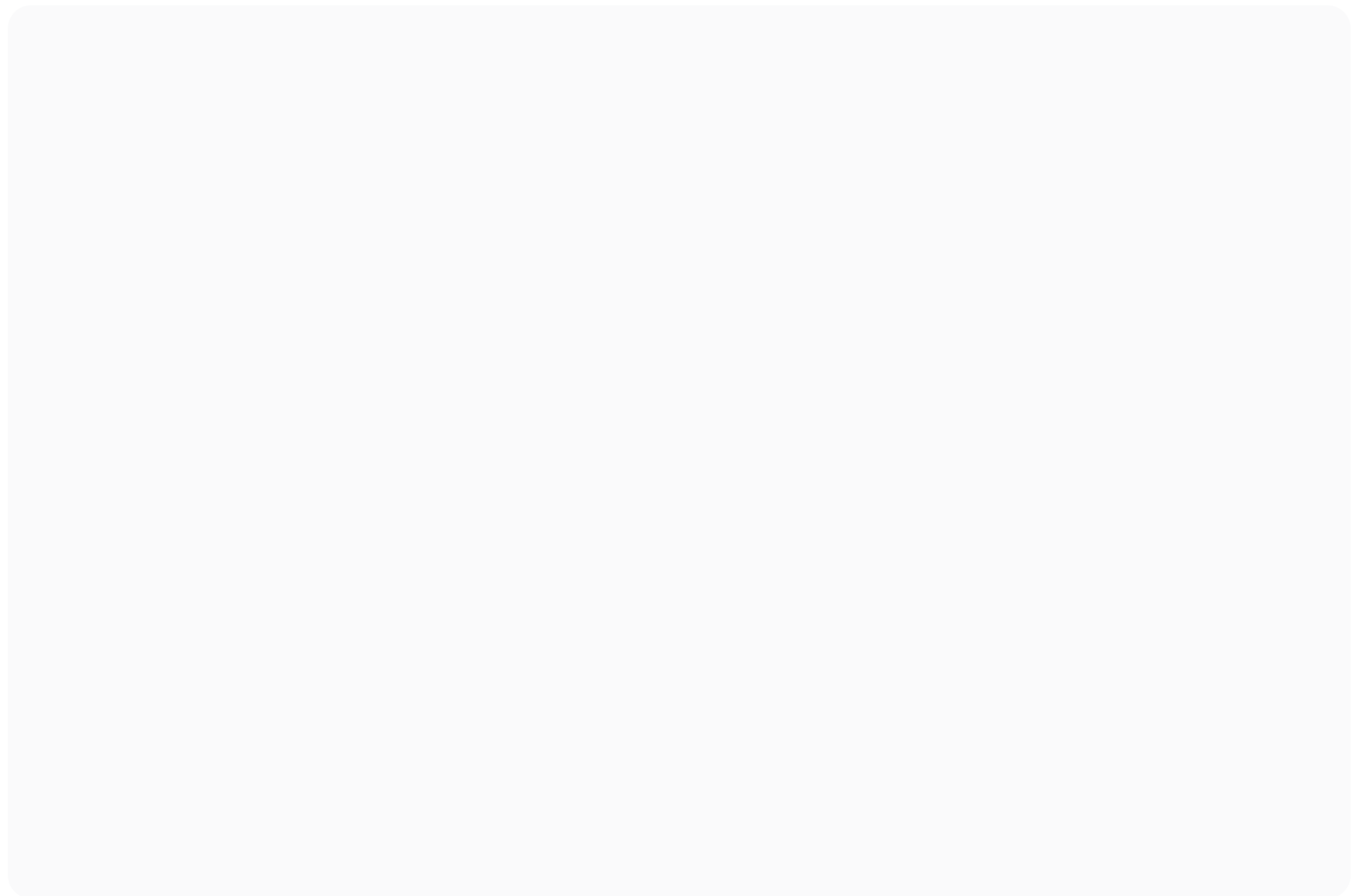

A note: The cable cars will be under maintenance till September 2025, resulting in a limited service.

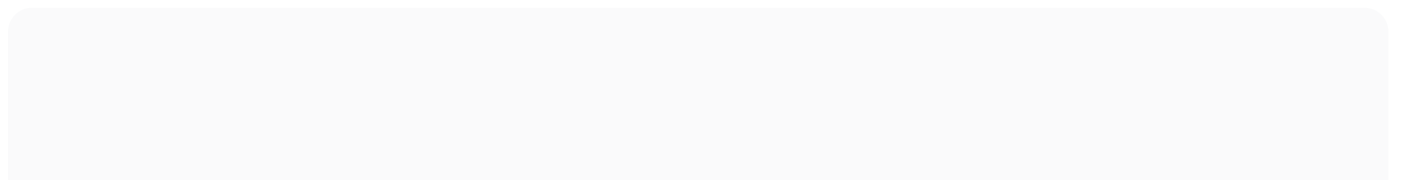
## **Experience the Venice Canals**

## Get Absorbed in Modern Art

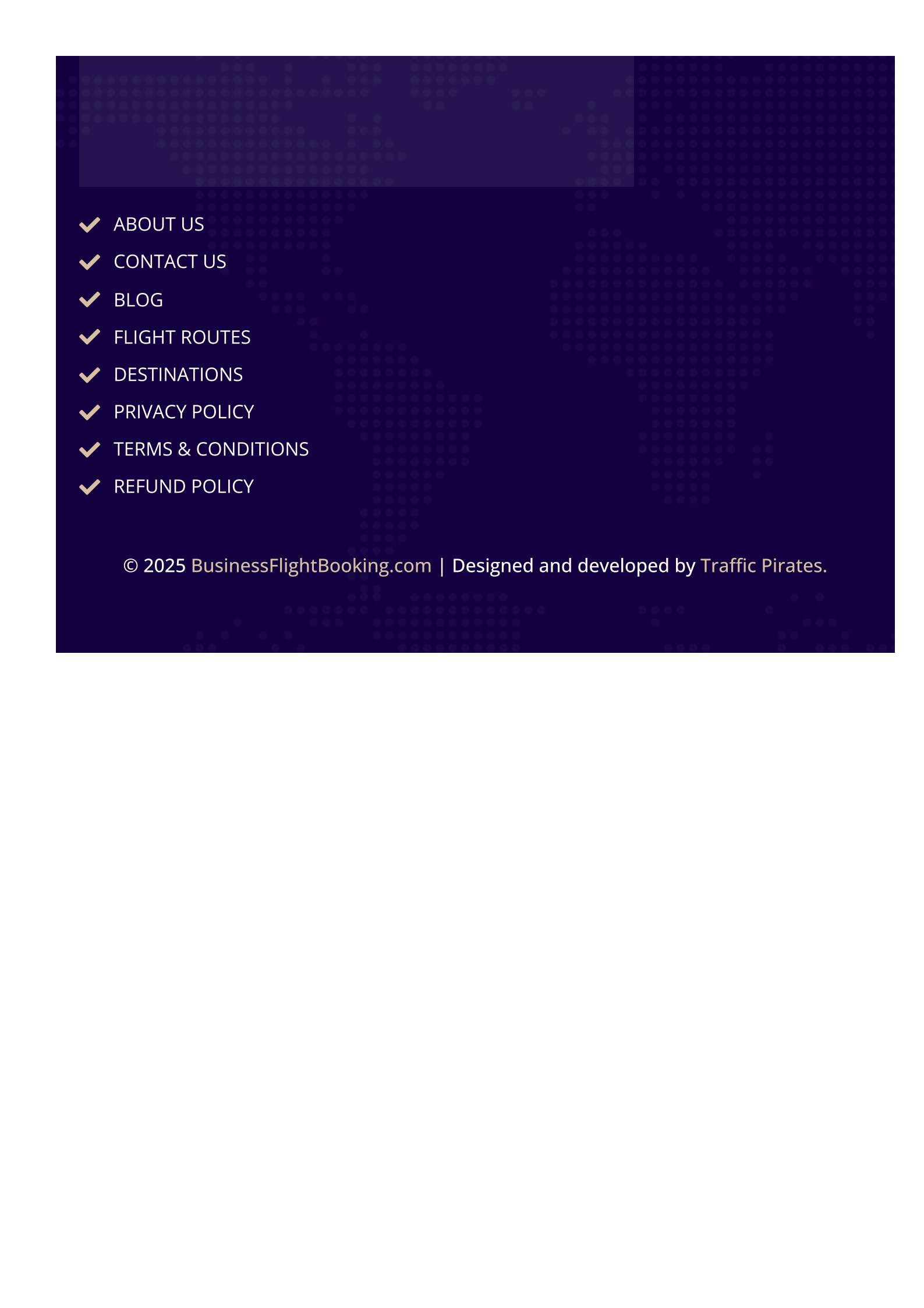
Interesting fact: Los Angeles. Museum of Contemporary art, or MOCA, is in fact a set of three museums in one!
